

## SELF ATTESTATION REGARDING IMMUNOCOMPROMISED STATUS

Currently, CDC recommends that moderately to severely immunocompromised people receive an additional dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine they received in their initial two-dose vaccine series.

This includes people who have:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response
